# CBS SUMMER AT THE MOVIES

The season finale curtain may have fallen in May, but it's often in the laziest months that TV stars get another big chance to shine bright. *Watch!* asks six CBS actors headlining some of the summer's hottest flicks about their giant leaps to the big screen. **By Jim Colucci**

## Danielle Panabaker (*Shark*)

*Mr. Brooks*

RELEASE DATE: JUNE 1

"I play Jane, the daughter of Kevin Costner and [CSI's] Marg Helgenberger, a Stanford freshman who comes home during her first semester under suspicious circumstances. Both Jane and my character Julie on *Shark* are very smart, but Julie is only 16, and is a straight-shooter. Jane is keeping secrets from her parents, so everything is a lie on top of a lie. I'm 19 and in my senior year at UCLA, so I know that that's what's so interesting about college—there's a lot more freedom, often to make mistakes. As an actor, that's great because you get to do things that in real life you'd go to jail for."



## Jason Segel (*How I Met Your Mother*)

*Knocked Up*

RELEASE DATE: JUNE 1

"I made TV shows *Freaks and Geeks* and *Undeclared* with [Knocked Up director] Judd Apatow, but this is our first movie together. We got to do a lot of improv, because Judd is a brilliant mentor who has assembled a little fraternity of creative, like-minded people. I love playing Marshall on *How I Met Your Mother*, but I must say it was nice after two years to go out and strut my stuff. I'm actually sort of the Barney in this movie: I'm one of Ben's three roommates, and I encourage him to sleep with Allison, and then berate him for not protecting himself. And then I keep trying to sleep with her—and her sister. So you'll see quite a lot more of me than you would expect. This film has an R rating for a reason."



## Jesse Lee Soffer (*As the World Turns*)

*Gracie*

RELEASE DATE: JUNE 1

"I play the protagonist's older brother, Johnny, a high school senior who dies in a car accident after a big soccer game. I was really honored that the producers saw something special enough in me that they would let me play their beloved real-life brother. Meanwhile, when I first took the role of Will Munson on *As the World Turns*, he was just getting out of an institution after having poisoned someone. He was supposedly rehabilitated but was still very dark, edgy and angry. Now he's about 19—I'm really 23—and for the most part he's a normal guy with a dark past. So he's truly nothing like Johnny, but I think they both do have good hearts."



## Wallace Langham (*CSI*)

*I Want Someone to Eat Cheese With*

RELEASE DATE: JUNE 6

"My character Claude Clochet is a cliché. He's a pompous theater actor from Chicago who reminds Jeff Garlin's character at every given opportunity how fantastic everything is going for him. My *CSI* character, David Hodges, can definitely be pompous, too, but he's also smart, socially inept and odd. He does get to deliver some fun, wisecrass one-liners, though, that break up some of the seriousness of the show. So I guess they both have an underlying comedic thread."

### James Woods (*Shark*)

#### *Surf's Up*

RELEASE DATE: JUNE 8

"I play the one and only Reggie Belafonte: a sea otter who is a Don King-like surf promoter. On *Shark*, I'm a lawyer. They're both sea creatures, and both will cajole, exploit and manipulate other people's lives for their own benefit. But when you look up narcissism, there's a picture of my little bucktoothed sea otter friend. At least Shark recognizes how other people feel and is willing to leave a bucket of chum or two for the other guy. Reggie thinks if there's a bucket of mackerel, he gets it all. *Surf's Up* was one of the two most enjoyable experiences I've had doing voice-over so far. I can't say what the other one is because I want everyone I've ever worked with to think it's them. That's a move both Reggie and Shark would pull."



### Sarah Carter (*Shark*)

#### *Skinwalkers*

RELEASE DATE: JULY 4

"I play Kat in *Skinwalkers*, and Madeline in *Shark*. They couldn't seem further apart: Kat is a small-town farm girl whose family comes first, and Madeline is a career-driven woman in L.A. But one is a werewolf, and one is a lawyer—so yes, there are some similarities. Everybody can relate to the werewolf myth, which is why it developed in the first place. When you embrace your inner animal, it opens up a world of power that all human beings are intrigued by, but very afraid of. I'm definitely in touch with the fire that's needed to find darker characters. I'm a believer that everything is understandable if you delve into the reason behind it, which is probably why I love being an actor."
